### Course Requirements

Students must complete all the core compulsory units within the program structure over 4 years (or part-time equivalent). Students will also be required to complete a major and minor area of study.

Each unit is usually worth 15 credit points.

A total of 480 credit points is compulsory to satisfy the program requirements of Initial Teacher Education (ITE) programs, as well as a minimum of 80 days professional experience. You will also be required to successfully complete external Literacy and Numeracy tests prior to registration as a teacher.

Please note that International Students are not eligible to study this program online.

Students will need to apply for a Working with Children Check (WWCC) card before commencing their program. A copy of the WWCC card must be supplied to the University prior to commencing professional experience placements. More information can be found at the WWCC website.

### **Major/Minor Disciplines**

It is a requirement that Pre-Service Teachers (PSTs) complete:

- One Major Studies of eight discipline elective units
- One Minor Studies of four discipline elective units

*plus*

- Two Curriculum units in each Major and Minor area of study (for a total of 4 units).
