Thanks to the generous support of our donors and sponsors, the Federation University Australia Foundation provides Foundation Scholarships that ease the financial burden experienced by students in need of assistance. Through the support of our donors, Foundation transforms lives every day and supports those students who are struggling financially.

In 2022, we awarded 194 Foundation Scholarships to the total value of \$552,000 with individual values ranging from \$500 to \$7000. These scholarships were awarded to higher education and TAFE students who demonstrated a strong commitment to study and had experienced economic disadvantage. Without this financial support, many of these students would not have been able to continue their studies and for many, it is the first time anyone has expressed belief in them.

We were able to hold Foundation Scholarship presentation events at all of our Victorian campuses during 2022.

To our donors, we say thank you for your belief, your generosity and support. Thank you for helping us to transform lives. The Foundation also acknowledges with gratitude funds donated to the University prior to the establishment of the Foundation, which enabled the creation of the overall scholarship fund. 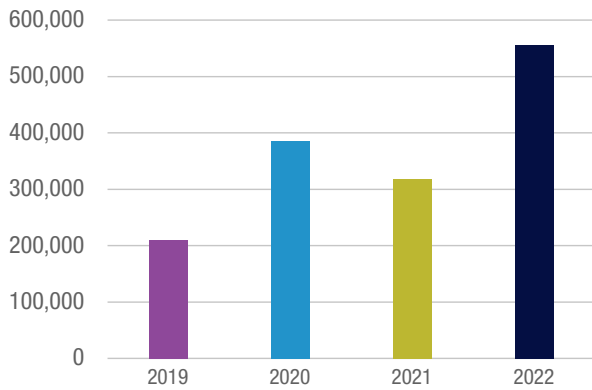

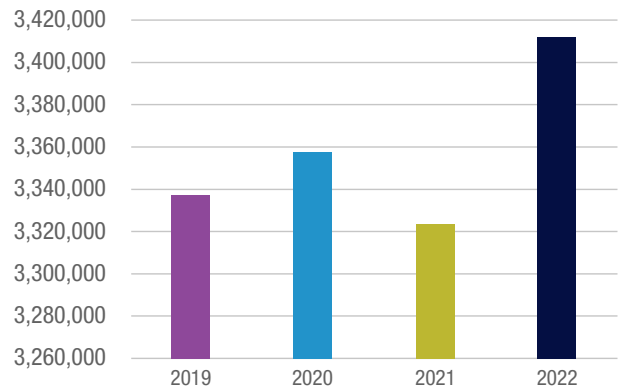

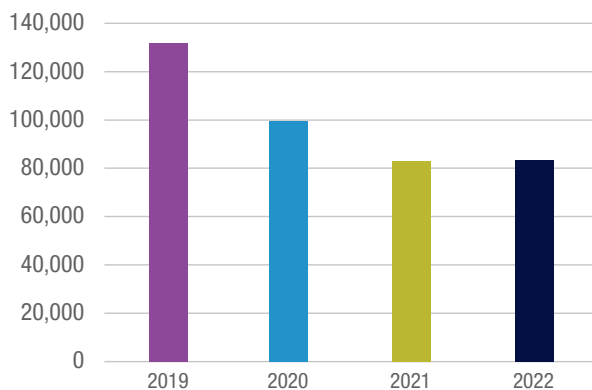
DONATIONS RECEIVED (\$)



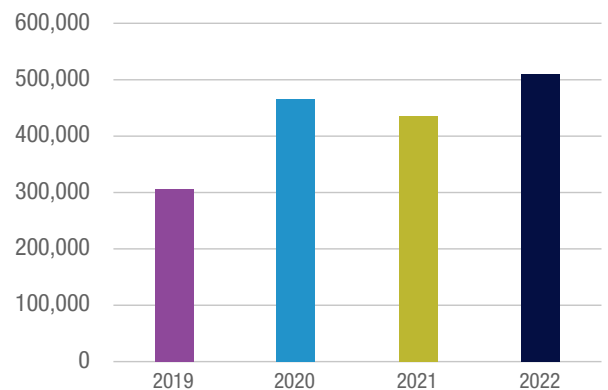
NET ASSETS (\$)



INVESTMENT INCOME (\$)

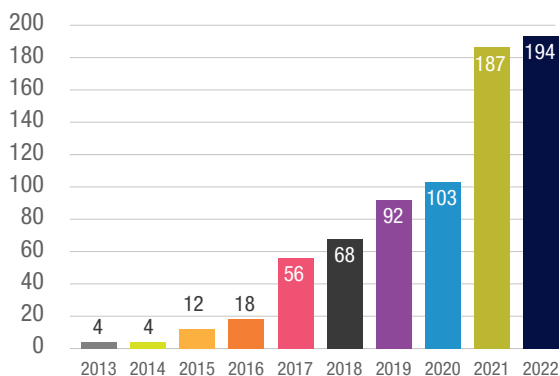


ANNUAL VALUE OF SCHOLARSHIPS GIVEN (\$)

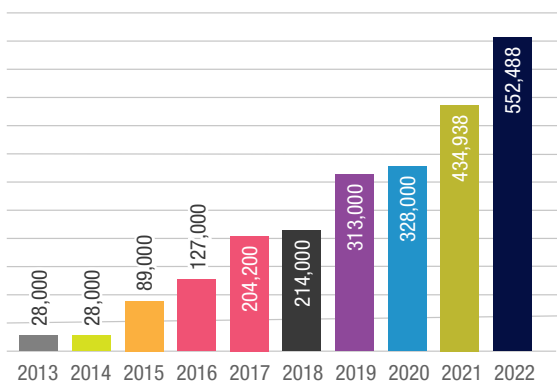


HISTORICAL FINANCIAL COMPARISON

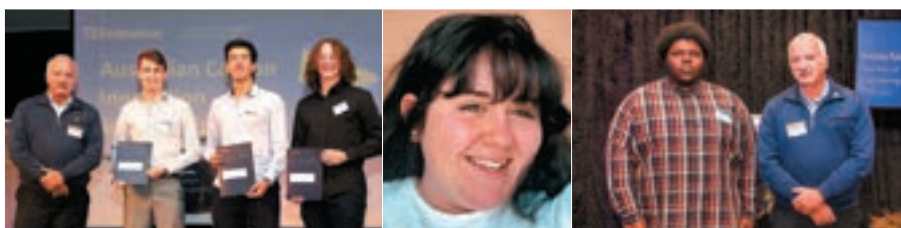

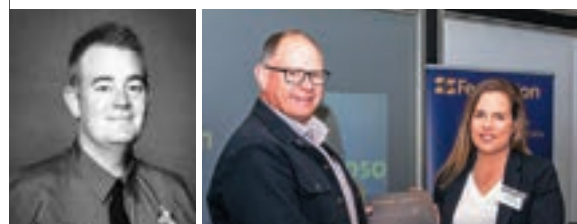
