Amendments to the Federation University Australia (Academic) Regulations 2022

1. Principal Regulations

In this Part, *principal Regulations* means the Federation University (Academic) Regulations 2022.

2. The Academic Board and its Committees

- (1) In Schedule 1 to the principal Regulations (Academic Board Charter), under the heading "Meetings": delete the words "ten (10) members" and replace them with the words "fifty per cent (50%) of the membership".
- (2) In Schedule 2 to the principal Regulations (Academic Board Administrative Committee Charter), under the heading "Meetings", delete the words "five (5) members" and replace them with the words "fifty per cent (50%) of the membership".
- (3) In Schedule 3 to the principal Regulations (Curriculum Committee Charter) -
 - (a) Under the heading "Membership":
 - (i) delete the sixth dot point; and
 - (ii) insert the sentence "Co-opted members do not have voting rights."
 - (b) Under the heading "Meetings": delete the words "seven (7) members" and replace them with the words "fifty per cent (50%) of the membership".
- (3) In Schedule 4 to the principal Regulations (Learning and Teaching Quality Committee Charter):
 - (a) Under the heading "Membership": insert the sentence "Coopted members do not have voting rights."
 - (b) Under the heading "Meetings": delete the words "seven (7) members" and replace them with the words "fifty per cent (50%) of the membership";
- (4) In Schedule 5 to the principal Regulations (Research Committee Charter) under the heading "Meetings", delete the words "five (5) members" and replace them with the words "fifty per cent (50%) of the membership".
