|-------------------------------|--|
| <b>Co-requisite (CoR):</b>    | A unit or units that must be completed concurrently with the chosen unit                               |
| <b>Pre-requisite (PR):</b>    | A unit or units that must be completed prior to undertaking another unit                               |
| <b>Exclusion(s)(EX):</b>      | A unit that is the equivalent to another unit & so excludes students from repeating an equivalent unit |
| <b>Introductory (Intro):</b>  | Units that are coded 1000 – 1999, introductory-level units   |
| <b>Intermediate (Inter.):</b> | Units that are coded 2000 – 2999, intermediate-level units   |
| <b>Advanced (Adv.):</b>       | Units that are coded 3000 – 3999, advanced-level units   |
| <b>Major/Minor:</b>           | The main subject area of study completed as part of a degree   |
| <b>Semester:</b>              | Designated teaching period   |
| <b>CR:</b>                    | Credit Point value   |
