**Attending Orientation is the best way to settle in quickly to your new life at Fed Uni.**

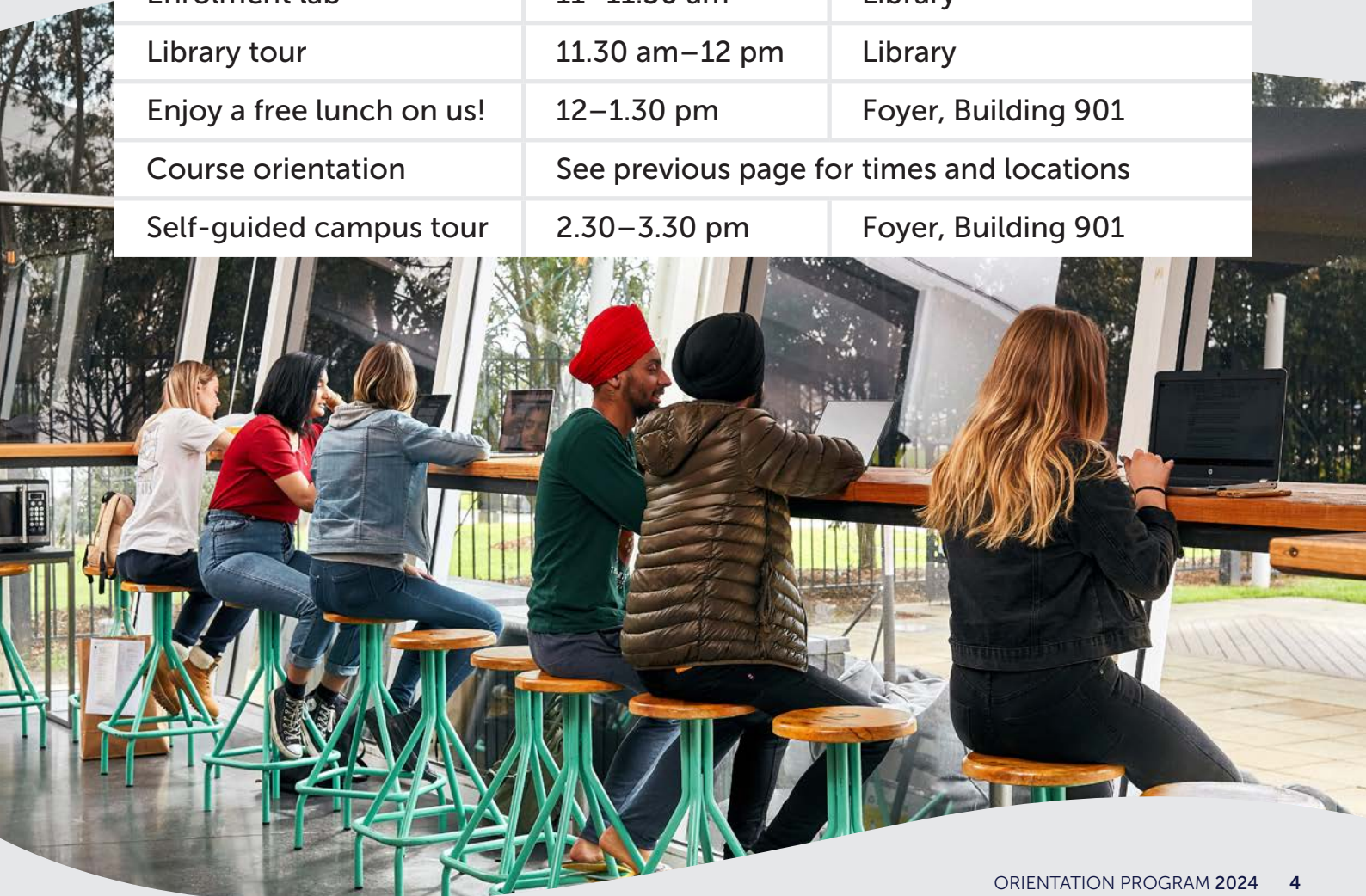
We want you to feel like Federation is your home away from home.
