CR: Credit Point value Introductory (Intro): Units that are coded 1000 – 1999, introductory-level units

Intermediate (Inter.): Units that are coded 2000 – 2999, intermediate-level units

Major/Minor: The main subject area of study completed as part of a degree

Semester: Designated teaching period
