Campus access

We have identified 83 staff members who are required to continue working on campus to ensure we can deliver online programs and maintain essential facilities and services across all campuses. To these staff members, we express our sincere thanks on behalf of the whole Federation community.

We understand some staff may prefer to be working from home during this difficult time and we wish to reassure all staff that social distancing and other hygiene measures will stay in place across our campuses even though they will only remain open to a small number of staff. From tomorrow, **Tuesday 7 April**, all other staff are required to notify security in advance before coming on to campus.
