WHAT IS ACADEMIC INTEGRITY?

Acting with honesty, trust, fairness, respect and responsibility in your studies and academic work (TEQSA, 2022).

Not acting with Academic Integrity includes:

- using someone else's (even AIs) ideas, information or words without acknowledging them
- colluding with others to complete your assessment task; or
- paying someone to write an essay for you (a friend or service).
