

2019 maximum student contribution amounts for a student place (equivalent full time student load)

For Commonwealth supported place students each course (unit) falls into one of three bands which determines the student contribution charged for the course. The maximum student contribution amounts below are based on a standard, full-time enrolment for a calendar year (120 credit points/1 EFTSL) with all courses (units) in the same band.

Band	Course (unit) discipline	Maximum annual student contribution amount
1	Behavioural Science, Clinical Psychology, Education*, Foreign Languages, Humanities, Nursing*, Social Studies, Visual & Performing Arts	\$6,566
2	Agriculture, Allied Health, Built Environment, Computing, Engineering, Mathematics, Other Health, Science, Statistics, Surveying	\$9,359
3	Accounting, Administration, Commerce, Dentistry, Economics, Law, Medicine, Veterinary Science	\$10,958

***NOTE:** For students who commenced their program of study before 1 January 2010, the maximum annual student contribution amount for Education and Nursing courses is \$5,254. Students who started their program of study on or after 1 January 2010 are subject to the maximum student contribution amount specified in the above table.

Student Contribution Amount for a Place - student contribution amount payable per EFTSL for a given course of study

Equivalent Full-Time Student Load (EFTSL) - measure of study load for a course as a measure of total required study load for a full year in undertaking your program on a full-time basis

Course Discipline - student contribution amount is determined by the discipline of each individual course of study, not the overall program

Maximum annual student contribution amount - annual cost for full-time study in a calendar year (1 EFTSL)
