

2022 maximum student contribution amounts for a student place (equivalent full time student load)

- > Maximum student contribution amounts are based on a standard, full-time enrolment for a calendar year (1 EFTSL) with all courses (subjects) in the same band
- > The student contribution you pay will depend on how many courses you enrol in, the study load of the courses and the band under which each course falls
- > Courses (subjects) are classified into a student contribution band, depending on the study area of the course
