Additional eligibility criteria required as part of the application process:

- Two written references for Higher Education or one written reference for TAFE like this [sample reference letter](#).
- Written responses within the application asking about your studies and the impact the scholarship would have on you (50-200 words)
- Questions about personal experience in eligibility form (Yes/No questions – some require details)

How to apply

We recommend setting aside 20-30 minutes to complete your application.

Before you start

Obtain one/two written references from your referees. See the [reference letter section of this page](#) for who can be your referee and the [sample reference letter](#).

Login

1. Click the link above to visit the Scholarships and Grants Portal page.
2. Scroll to the bottom of the login page and click 'Or Sign in with Federation University'.
3. Login with your Student ID, and password.

Update your Eligibility profile.

1. Click your name on the top right, then click My Account
2. Click Eligibility on the left-hand menu.
3. Select 'Update your eligibility profile'.
4. Complete the short survey, this should only take 1-3 minutes.
5. Click 'Save my profile'.

Apply for your scholarship.

1. After clicking 'Save my profile' you'll be shown Eligible Programs
2. Click on the scholarship to access the details.
3. Click 'Apply'
4. Complete the 'Pre-Eligibility Questions'
5. If relevant, complete the 'Written responses' and 'Eligibility Form'.
6. Click 'Submit'

Scholarships and Grants Portal
