

# Student Evaluation of Learning & Teaching (SELT) Survey Questions

The Student Evaluation of Learning & Teaching (SELT) is run during every teaching period and invites enrolled students to leave their feedback regarding unit delivery and quality of teaching at Federation. The survey is split into two parts: teaching feedback and unit feedback.

Results of the survey are reported as averaged ratings and as percentages of students that “Agree” or “Strongly Agree” with each quantitative statement.

## SELT Teacher and Unit Selection

At the beginning of the survey, students are presented with a list of teachers and units fetched from the enrolment and timetable systems which they may provide feedback for. All selections are optional, but at least one teacher and one course must be selected to proceed with the survey.

Each student’s teachers and units are generated approximately one week from the survey’s commencement date. Units that were dropped within the two days prior to census date are also selectable for feedback.

Students may also search for up to three additional teachers or units from a dropdown list, in case some relevant options are not presented.

## SELT Teaching Feedback Items

The Teaching Feedback portion of the survey has nine questions; two selection questions, six quantitative and one qualitative. Students may indicate Never, Sometimes, About half the time, Most of the time, Always or Not Applicable for each quantitative item.

Question 1 is presented once at the beginning of the survey. Questions 2 through 9 are presented for every teacher that was selected by a student at the survey’s beginning.

## SELT Unit Feedback Items

The Unit Feedback portion of the survey has six questions; five quantitative and one qualitative. Students may indicate Strongly Agree, Agree, Neutral, Disagree, Strongly Disagree or Not Applicable for each qualitative item.
