

Maximum student contribution amounts

- > Maximum student contribution amounts are based on a standard, full-time enrolment for a calendar year (120 credit points/1 EFTSL) with all units in the same band
- > Units are grouped into bands by their field of education and each band has a different student contribution amount set by the Australian Government each year
- > The student contribution amount you pay for a year will depend on how many units you enrol in, the study load of the unit and the bands under which each unit falls
