

Important information

- > Program and fee information applies to students studying between 1 January and 31 December 2020 (fee paying students who commenced a program prior to 1 Jan 2018 will retain their commencement year annual fee)
- > Fees are held fixed for each calendar year 1 January until 31 December
- > Fees are reviewed on an annual basis and may increase in the following calendar year, fee increases are applied at the beginning of each calendar year
- > Equivalent Full Time Study Load (EFTSL) is a measure of study load for a full year when undertaking a program on a full-time basis (120 credit points = 1 EFTSL i.e. 8 courses x 15 credit points)
- > Program annual fees are based on a full-time study load (1 EFTSL / 120 credit points) in the same calendar year
- > Semester fees are based on a full-time study load (.5 EFTSL / 60 credit points) and the final tuition fee payable each semester will be determined by your course enrolments
- > The semester fee is an estimate only as fees may increase in future years the amount you must pay is the tuition fee which has been approved for the calendar year in which the semester falls
- > A student commencing in Semester Two or Summer Semester will find that their total program cost will be slightly higher than if they had commenced in Semester One
- > For all programs listed students will be charged an additional tuition fee where a course needs to be repeated
