#### University update

Darren Holland advised that the new Chair would meet Minister of Education Dan Tehan during his upcoming visit. Darren noted Orientation and Semester 1 planning were going well with strong student intake.

Darren advised that less than 100 Federation students in China would unable to reach campus in time to commence due to the novel coronavirus outbreak. The majority of these will continue online, some will defer. The University is mindful of how decreasing international visitors will effect tourism which will impact local businesses and in turn impact students seeking jobs.
