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Course Requirements

Students must complete all the core compulsory units within the course structure over 4 years (or part-time equivalent).

Students will also be required to complete a total of **twelve discipline elective units** across **two areas of study**. Students also complete **two Curriculum units** in each Major study area for a total for four (see below).

Each unit is usually worth 15 credit points.

A total of 480 credit points is compulsory to satisfy the course requirements of Initial Teacher Education (ITE) course, as well as a minimum of 80 days professional experience. You will also be required to successfully complete external Literacy and Numeracy tests prior to registration as a teacher.

Please note that International Students are not eligible to study this course online.

Students will need to apply for a Working with Children Check (WWCC) card before commencing their course. A copy of the WWCC card must be supplied to the University prior to commencing professional experience placements. More information can be found at the WWCC website.

Major Discipline Electives

It is a requirement that Pre-Service Teachers (PSTs) complete:

- Two Major Studies of six discipline elective units each (for a total of 12 units) from two discipline sequence/study areas *plus*
- Two Curriculum units in each Major area of study (for a total of 4 units)

PLEASE NOTE: Physical Education and Outdoor Education cannot be chosen together (students wanting this combination would do this via the Badged Stream and have health as an additional discipline).
