

Federation University Australia

Federation University Australia (Miscellaneous Amendments) Regulations 2024

In accordance with sections 53 and 54 of the Federation University Australia Statute 2021, I, Duncan Bentley, Vice-Chancellor and President of Federation University Australia, make amendments to the following Regulations as described below:

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Part 1 - Amendments to the Federation University Australia (Academic) Regulations 2022

1. Principal Regulations

In this Part, *principal Regulations* means the Federation University (Academic) Regulations 2022.

2. Part 1 – Objectives

- (1) The principal Regulations are amended as follows:
 - (a) In regulation 1 (a) and (f) delete the words “*programs*” and replace them with the words “*courses*”;
 - (b) In regulation 1 (e) delete the words “Academic Board Administrative Committee” and replace them with the words “Academic Board Steering Committee”.

3. Part 1 – Preliminary: Definitions

- (1) In regulation (4) of the principal Regulations insert the definitions of Unit, Course and Course specification in its alphabetical position.
- (2) In regulations (4) of the principal Regulations remove the definitions of Course, Program and Program specification.

4. Part 2 - Academic Governance

- (1) In Regulation 6(2)(b) of the principal Regulations delete the words “*programs*” and replace them with the word “*courses*”;
- (2) In Regulation 10(1)(a) of the principal Regulations delete the words “*Academic Board Administrative Committee*” and replace them with the words “*Academic Board Steering Committee*”;

5. Part 3 - Establishment and Review of Programs and Units

- (1) The principal Regulations are amended as follows:
 - (a) Delete the word “*Programs*” and replace it with the word “*Courses*” in the title of Part 3;
 - (b) Delete the word “*Courses*” and replace it with the word “*Units*” in the title of Part 3;
 - (c) In Regulation 12 of the principal Regulations delete the words “*programs*” and replace them with the words “*courses*”;
 - (d) In Regulation 12 of the principal Regulations delete the words “*program*” and replace them with the words “*course*”;

In Regulation 13 of the principal Regulations delete the words “*programs*” and replace them with the words “*courses*”;
 - (e) In Regulation 13 of the principal Regulations delete the words “*program*” and replace them with the words “*course*”;
 - (f) In Regulation 13 of the principal Regulations delete the words “*courses*” and replace them with the words “*units*”;
 - (g) In Regulation 13 of the principal Regulations delete the words “*course*” and replace them with the words “*unit*”;

- (h) In Regulation 14 of the principal Regulations delete the words “*program*” and replace them with the words “*course*”;
- (i) In Regulation 14 of the principal Regulations delete the words “*course*” and replace them with the words “*unit*”;
- (j) In Regulation 15 of the principal Regulations delete the words “*programs*” and replace them with the words “*courses*”;
- (k) In Regulation 15 of the principal Regulations delete the words “*courses*” and replace them with the words “*units*”.

6. Part 5 - Miscellaneous

- (1) In Regulation 17(2) of the principal Regulations delete the words “*standing orders*” and replace “*terms of reference*” with “*charters*”.

7. The Schedules - The Academic Board and its Committees:

- (1) In Schedule 1 to the principal Regulations (Academic Board Charter):
 - (a) Under the heading “Academic governance”;
 - (i) delete the words “*programs*” and replace them with the word “*courses*”;
 - (b) Under the heading “Functions”:
 - (i) include the word “*courses*” in “*approve proposed new academic and other programs leading to an award*”;
 - (ii) delete “*Academic Board Administrative Committee*” and substitute the phrase “*Academic Board Steering Committee*” after the phrase “*between meetings, decide urgent matters by circular resolution, which matters have been referred to it for decision by the Academic*”.
 - (c) Under the heading “Reviews”:
 - (i) delete “*terms of reference*” and substitute “*Charter*” after the phrase “*review the performance of its standing committees against their*” in the first dot point;
 - (d) Under the heading “Membership of the Academic Board”:
 - (i) change the membership of the “Ex officio members” as follows;
 - add *Deputy Chair, appointed by the Vice-Chancellor from the Higher Education representatives of the Committee (optional)*;
 - add *Vice-Chancellor*;
 - add *Provost*;
 - remove *DVC (Academic)*
 - remove *DVC (Research and Innovation)*
 - remove *DVC and CE TAFE*
 - add *Senior TAFE representative nominated by the Provost*;
 - add *Associate DVC Reconciliation, or nominee*”
 - (ii) delete “*Note: See section 22(1) of the Statute in relation to the appointment of the Chairperson.*” In the “*Note*” subsection of the first dot point in the “*Ex officio members*” subheading;
 - (iii) insert “*Note: See section 22(1) of the Statute in relation to the appointment of the Chairperson.*” As footnote number two to the first dot point in the “*Ex officio members*” subheading;
 - (iv) delete “*Note: See section 22(2) of the Statute in relation to the appointment of the Deputy Chairperson.*” In the “*Note*” subsection of the second dot point in the “*Ex officio members*” subheading;

- (v) insert “*Note: See section 22(2) of the Statute in relation to the appointment of the Deputy Chairperson.*” As footnote number three to the third dot point in the “Ex officio members” subheading;
 - (vi) change the membership of the “Elected members” as follows;
 - add “*one member of general/professional staff*”
 - (vii) remove “*at least one of whom shall be an international student*” and insert “*Note: One elected student shall be an international student. If none of the elected students are international, then a separate election will be held for an international student representative*” as footnote number five to the sixth dot point in the “Elected members” subheading;
 - (viii) insert “*A complete and public listing of the University’s courses is available here.*” as footnote number four which is referenced after the action in (vi) in the second dot point;
- (e) Under the heading “Academic Board Chair” insert the words “Associate or” before the phrase “*Professorial-level current or former academic or equivalent*”.
- (f) Under the heading “Appointment of Deputy Chair”:
- (i) delete “*The Vice-Chancellor will appoint a Deputy Chair from the members of the Academic Board.*” and substitute the phrase “*The Vice-Chancellor will appoint a Deputy Chair(s) from the members of the Academic Board from TAFE and Higher Education*” in as the first paragraph;
 - (ii) delete “*The Deputy Chair holds office for a two-year term, which office in addition to their current position on the Board which does not fall vacant due to their appointment.*” and substitute the sentence “*The Deputy Chair/s hold office for a two-year term, which office in addition to their current position on the Board which does not fall vacant due to their appointment.*” in as the second paragraph;
 - (iii) delete “*The Deputy Chair may be reappointed for an additional two-year term (i.e. the Deputy Chair may serve a maximum of two consecutive two-year terms).*” and substitute the sentence “*The Deputy Chair/s may be reappointed for an additional two-year term (i.e. the Deputy Chair/s may serve a maximum of two consecutive two-year terms).*” in as the third paragraph;
- (g) Under the heading “Terms of office”:
- (i) delete “*Academic Board members elected by staff shall serve for a term not exceeding two years. Members elected by students hold office for a term not exceeding two years. Members may be re-appointed. No elected member can serve for more than six years whether those years are consecutive or not.*” and substitute “*Academic Board members elected by staff shall serve a two-year term. Members elected by students hold office for a one-year term. Members may be re-appointed. No elected member can serve for more than six years whether those years are consecutive or not.*” in as the first paragraph;
- (h) Under the heading “Academic Board Standing Committees”:
- (i) delete “*Academic Board Administrative Committee*” and substitute the phrase “*Academic Board Steering Committee*” in the first dot-point;
 - (ii) delete the words “*programs*” and substitute the word “*courses*”;
 - (iii) in relation to the Curriculum Committee, delete “*to be chaired by the Associate DVC (Academic) or a nominee of the DVC (Academic)*” and substitute the phrase “*to be chaired by a nominee of the Provost;*”;
 - (iv) in relation to the Learning and Teaching Quality Committee, delete “*to be chaired by the Dean, Learning and Teaching or a nominee of the DVC (Academic);*” and substitute the phrase “*to be chaired by a nominee of the Provost;*”;
 - (v) in relation to the Research Committee, delete “*to be chaired by the Associate DVC (Research and Innovation) or a nominee of the DVC (Research and Innovation).*” and substitute the phrase “*to be chaired by a nominee of the Provost;*”;

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(2) In Schedule 2 to the principal Regulations (Academic Board Administrative Committee Charter):

- (a) Change heading from “*Academic Board Administrative Committee Charter*” and substitute the phrase “*Academic Board Steering Committee Charter*”;
- (b) Delete “*Academic Board Administrative Committee Charter*” and substitute the phrase “*Academic Board Steering Committee Charter*” in the first paragraph;
- (c) Under the heading “Purpose”:
 - (i) delete “*Academic Board Administrative Committee*” and substitute the phrase “*Academic Board Steering Committee*”;
- (d) Under the heading “Membership”;
 - (i) change “Membership” as follows:
 - delete *Deputy Chair of the Academic Board* and substitute *Deputy Chair/s of the Academic Board*;
 - add *Provost*;
 - remove *DVC (Academic)*
 - remove *DVC (Research and Innovation)*
 - add *A nominee of the Provost from research*;
 - add *Chief Learning Experience Officer, or nominee*;
 - remove *DVC and CE TAFE*
- (e) Under the heading “Appointment of Deputy Chair”:
 - (i) delete the sentence “*The Vice-Chancellor will appoint a Deputy Chair from the members of the Committee.*” and substitute the sentence “*The Deputy Chair/s of the Academic Board will act as the Deputy Chair/s of the Academic Board Steering Committee.*” in the first paragraph;
 - (ii) delete the sentence “*The Deputy Chair holds office for a two-year term, which office is in addition to the Deputy Chair’s current position on the Committee (which position does not fall vacant due to their appointment).*” from the second paragraph;
 - (iii) delete the sentence “*The Deputy Chair may be reappointed for an additional two-year term (i.e. the Deputy Chair may serve a maximum of two consecutive two-year terms).*” from the third paragraph;
- (f) delete the second appearing heading “Meeting”;
- (g) Insert heading “Reporting”:
 - (i) insert “*The Committee must report to the Academic Board.*” in the first paragraph;
 - (ii) insert “*through a summary report from the Chair attached to the Committee minutes;*” as the first dot point;
 - (iii) insert “*if a significant or material matter of concern arises; and*” as the second dot point;
 - (iv) insert “*annually, on the performance of its functions and the achievement of its objectives.*” as the third dot point;

(3) In Schedule 3 to the principal Regulations (Curriculum Committee Charter):

- (a) Under the heading “Purpose” delete “*programs*” and substitute “*courses*”.
- (b) Under heading “Functions”:
 - (i) delete the words “*programs*” and replace them with the word “*courses*”;
 - (ii) delete “*DVC (Academic), DVC (Research and Innovation)*” and substitute “*Provost*” in the second dot point after “*The Committee is authorised to*”;
 - (iii) delete “*DVC and CE TAFE*” and substitute “*Provost*” in the third dot point after “*The Committee is authorised to*”;

- (iv) insert “and” in the first dot point following the phrase “*all additions and deletions of VET products from the University’s Scope of Registration*” after “*approve, on recommendation made by the Provost*”;
 - (v) delete “and” in the second dot point following the phrase “*delivery of VET products and updated VET products for third-party delivery.*” after “*approve, on recommendation made by the Provost*”;
 - (vi) delete “*credit-bearing micro-credentials and micro-programs at TAFE level and changes to or termination of credit-bearing micro-credentials and micro-programs,*” in the third dot point;
 - (vii) delete “*develop and determine*” and substitute “*approve*” in the fourth dot point after “*The Committee is authorised to*”;
 - (viii) insert “*assure the quality and effectiveness of educational innovations*” in the fifth dot point after “*The Committee is authorised to*”;
 - (ix) delete the words “*program*” and replace them with the word “*course*”;
 - (x) delete “*provide advice to the Academic Board on—*”
 - *quality of curriculum and assessment design, and development, and educational innovation, and currency of delivery to maintain a high quality student learner experience and graduate outcomes*
 - *quality and outcomes of pathways opportunities, implementation and outcomes to ensure access, equity, a high quality student learner experience and graduate outcomes;*
- (c) Under the heading “*Membership*”, change membership as follows:
delete “*Chair: Appointed by the DVC (Academic)*” and substitute “*Chair: A nominee of the Provost*”
- (i) delete “*Director, Wimmera*” and substitute “*Chair, TAFE Course Approval Committee, or nominee*”
 - (ii) delete “*Chair, Learning and Teaching Quality Committee*” and substitute “*Chair, Learning and Teaching Quality Committee*”
 - (iii) add “*Chair, Academic Board, or nominee*”
 - (iv) change “*Dean, Graduate Studies*” to “*Dean, Graduate Research*”
 - (v) add “*nominee*” after “*Dean, Global Professional School*”
 - (vi) delete “*Deputy Chief Executive TAFE*” and substitute “*Deputy Chief Executive TAFE, or nominee of the Provost*”;
 - (vii) delete “*Senior Manager, Registrar Services*” and substitute “*Director, Student Services and Registrar or nominee*”;
 - (viii) delete “*Associate Director, Academic Services and Support Division (ASSD)*” and substitute “*nominee of the Chief Operating Officer*”;
 - (ix) Insert “*and cannot be appointed as Deputy Chair*” in the last sentence after “*Co-opted members do not have voting rights*”;
- (d) Under the heading “*Election of Deputy Chair*” delete “*at its first meeting each year for a one-year term*” and substitute the sentence “*via electronic ballot at the start of the year for a one-year term*” after the phrase “*The Committee will elect a Deputy Chair from its members*”;
- (4) In Schedule 4 to the principal Regulations (Learning and Teaching Quality Committee Charter):
- (a) insert “*The term ‘learning and teaching’ refers to all University teaching, learning, education and training activities.*” As footnote number one to the second paragraph.
 - (b) Under the heading “*Functions*”:
 - (i) delete the words “*programs*” and replace them with the words “*courses*” in the first dot point;
 - (ii) insert the words “*delivering high learning satisfaction and graduate outcomes*” after the words “*quality of teaching and learning*” in the first dot point;
 - (iii) insert the words “*including meeting and exceeding requirements for accredited courses*” after the words “*high academic standards*” in the second dot point;

- (iv) insert the words “*assure the Academic Board that the quality of learning and teaching is consistently innovative and developing with best practice*” as the third dot point;
- (v) insert the words “*innovation, learner satisfaction, graduate outcomes*” after the words “*learning to assure quality*” in the fifth dot point;
- (vi) delete the words “*program*” and replace them with the words “*course*” in the sixth dot point;
- (c) Under the heading “Responsibilities”:
- (i) insert the words “*which assures high learner satisfaction and graduate and*” after the words “*learning quality assurance framework*” in the first dot point;
- (ii) insert the words “*delivering high learner satisfaction and graduate outcomes*” after the words “*quality of learning and teaching*” in the second dot point;
- (iii) insert the words “*learner satisfaction, graduate outcomes*” after the words “*quality of learning and teaching*” in the third dot point;
- (iv) insert “*learner satisfaction and graduate outcomes*” in the first dot point following the phrase “*reviewing regular performance reports on*” in the fourth dot point;
- (v) insert the words “*including that it is consistently innovative and developing with best practice to ensure high learner satisfaction and graduate outcomes*” of the second dot point following the phrase “*quality assuring learning and teaching related policy documents, monitoring implementation and evaluating outcomes including in relation to*” after the words “*continuous improvement of teaching quality*” in the fifth dot point;
- (vi) delete the sentence “*assuring the processes associated with student complaints, grievances, reviews of decisions and appeals relating to learning and teaching to ensure a high quality student experience;*” and insert the sentence “*Receive reports on student complaints, grievances, reviews of decisions and appeals relating to learning and teaching to ensure a high quality student experience*” in as the sixth dot point;
- (vii) insert the word “*assuring*” before the words “*academic integrity*” in the seventh dot point;
- (viii) insert the words “*receive reports on*” in place of “*assuring*” in the eighth dot point.
- (d) Under the heading “Membership”:
- (i) change the membership of the “Ex officio members” as follows;
- delete “*Chair: Dean, Teaching and Learning or a nominee of the DVC (Academic)*” and substitute “*Chair: a nominee of the Provost*”
 - add “*or nominee*” after “*Chair, Academic Board*”
 - change “*Dean, Graduate Studies*” to “*Dean, Graduate Research*” and add “*or nominee*”
 - add “*or nominee*” after “*Dean, Global Professional School*”
 - add “*or nominee*” after “*Director, Learner Experience and Excellence (TAFE)*”
 - add “*A nominee of the Provost responsible for academic quality and accreditation*”
 - add “*or nominee*” to “*Chief Learner Experience Officer*”
 - add “*or nominee*” after “*Director, University Library*”
- (ii) change the membership of the “Elected members” as follows;
- add “*one member of the general/professional staff*”
- (iii) change the membership of the “Co-opted members” to the following;
- delete “*two*” and substitute “*four*”
- (iv) Insert “*and cannot be appointed as Deputy Chair*” in the last sentence after “*Co-opted members do not have voting rights*”;
- (e) Under the heading “Election of Deputy Chair” in the first sentence;
- (i) Insert “*within its eligible staff*”;
- (ii) delete “*at its first meeting each year for a one-year term*” and substitute with the words “*via electronic ballot at the start of the year for a one-year term.*” after the

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phrase “*The Committee will elect a Deputy Chair*”;

(5) In Schedule 5 to the principal Regulations (Research Committee Charter):

- (a) Under the heading “Membership”:
 - (i) change the membership of the “Ex officio members” as follows;
 - delete “*Chair: Associate DVC (Research and Innovation) or a nominee of the DVC (Research and Innovation)*” and substitute “*Chair: a nominee of the Provost*”
 - change “*Director, Research, Innovation and Enterprise*” to “*Director, Research and Innovation*”
 - add “*or nominee*” after “*Director, University Library*”
 - (ii) change the membership of the “Elected members” as follows;
 - add “*(Level A-E)*” after “*one higher education academic*”
 - change “*one member of TAFE, and*” to “*one staff member of TAFE (optional)*”
 - add “*one member of the general/professional staff*”
 - (iii) Insert “*Co-opted members*” as the third members list with the following;
 - “*up to four members co-opted by the Committee.*”
 - (iv) Insert “*Co-opted members do not have voting rights and cannot be appointed as Deputy Chair*” in the last sentence after”;
- (b) Under the heading “*Election of Deputy Chair*” in the first sentence;
 - (i) Insert “*within its eligible staff*”;
 - (ii) delete “*at its first meeting each year for a one year term*” and substitute with the words “*via electronic ballot at the start of the year for a one-year term*” after the phrase “*The Committee will elect a Deputy Chair*”;

(6) In Schedule 6 to the principal Regulations (Assessment Descriptions and Grade Descriptions):

- (a) delete the words “*programs*” and replace them with the words “*courses*” in the first paragraph;
- (b) delete the words “*program*” and replace them with the words “*course*” in the first paragraph;
- (c) delete the words “*courses*” and replace them with the words “*units*” in the first paragraph;
- (d) delete the words “*programs*” and replace them with the words “*courses*” in the first paragraph of section E;
- (e) delete the words “*program*” and replace them with the words “*course*” in the first paragraph of section E;
- (f) delete the words “*courses*” and replace them with the words “*units*” in the first paragraph of section E;

Part 2 - Amendments to the Federation University Australia (Operations) Regulations 2022

1. Principal Regulations

In this Part, **principal Regulations** means the Federation University (Operations) Regulations 2022.

2. Definitions

(1) In regulation (4) of the principal Regulations remove the words “*program or courses*” and substitute the phrase “*course, program or unit*”.

3. Membership of the Higher Education Business Approval Committee

(1) In regulation 8 of the principal Regulations change the “Higher Education Business Approval Committee” to the following:

- (a) Change “*the Deputy Vice Chancellor (Academic), who is the Chair*” to “*the Provost, who is the Chair*”;

4. Membership of and reporting by the TAFE Course Approval Committee

(1) In regulation 11 of the principal Regulations change the “TAFE Course Approval Committee” to the following:

- (a) change “the Director, Skills and Education Delivery, who is the Deputy Chair” to “the Deputy, CEO, TAFE, who is the Deputy Chair;”
- (b) change “*the Senior Manager, Policy and Quality Services, or nominee*” to “the Senior Manager, Quality Services, or nominee;”

5. Categories of fees, charges and penalties

(1) In regulation 67(2)(h) of the principal Regulations delete the words “*program and unit*” and substitute the phrase “*program, course and unit*”.

6. Withholding of results and exclusion

(1) In regulation 68 of the principal Regulations substitute the phrase “*or course*” after the phrase “*exclude persons for program*”.

7. Technology Parks and Innovation Centres

(1) In regulation 63 of the principal Regulations replace the heading “Advisory Committee” to “Monitoring” followed by:

- (a) In section 1, replace “*There continues to be a Business Asset Review Committee*” with “*The operations of the Technology Parks shall be monitored via the Resources Committee.*”
- (b) Delete sections 2 and 3 being:
 - “2) *The Committee comprises—*
 - (a) *the Chair, appointed by the Council;*
 - (b) *other members appointed by the Council.*
 - 3) *Meetings of the Committee shall be in accordance with Terms of Reference established by the Council.*”

(2) Delete regulation 64 of the principal Regulations as follows:

- (a) “*Management of Technology Parks*
 - (1) *The Council may appoint a Director of Technology Parks and Innovation Centres.*

- (2) *The functions of the Director are—*
- (a) *to control and manage Technology Parks and Innovation Centres on behalf of the University;*
 - (b) *to report to the Advisory Committee at regular intervals in relation to the commercial development and operations of the Technology Parks and Innovation Centres.”*

Part 3 - Amendments to the Federation University Australia (Students) Regulations 2022

1. Principal Regulations

In this Part, *principal Regulations* means the Federation University (Operations) Regulations 2022.

2. Interpretation

(1) In regulation 4 of the principal Regulations:

- (a) Delete the phrase “*program or course*” and substitute the phrase “*course, program, course and unit*”;
- (b) Delete the words “*program*” and substitute the phrase “*course or program*”;

3. Entry requirements

(1) In regulation 7 of the principal Regulations substitute the phrase “*course or*” before the word “*program*” in subsection (1) and 2(b).

4. Selection is at the University’s discretion

(1) In regulation 8 of the principal Regulations:

- (a) delete the phrase “*program or course*” and substitute the phrase “*course, program or unit*” in subsection (1);
- (b) delete the phrase “*program or course*” and substitute the phrase “*course, program or unit*” in subsection (3)(b) and (c);

5. Readmission after absence or exclusion

(1) In regulation 10 of the principal Regulations:

- (a) insert the words “*course or*” before the words “*program*”; in subsection (1), (2), (3)(b) and (4);
- (b) delete the word “*courses*” and substitute the word “*units*” in subsection (3) and (4);

6. Eligibility to defer

(1) In regulation 11 of the principal Regulations insert the words “*course or*” before the word “*program*” in subsection (1) and (2)(a).

7. Maximum period of deferral

(1) In regulation 12 of the principal Regulations:

- (a) insert the words “*course or*” before the words “*program*” in subsection (1) and (1)(b);
- (b) delete the word “*program*” and substitute the word “*course*” in subsection (1)(a);

8. Notification after deferral

(1) In regulation 13 of the principal Regulations insert the words “*course or*” before the words “*program*” in subsection (1).

9. Study in Programs

(1) In Part 3 of the principal Regulations insert the words “*Course and*” before the word “*Programs*” in the title of the regulation.

10. Imposition of conditions

(1) In regulation 20 of the principal Regulations delete the word “*courses*” and substitute the word “*units*” in subsection (2)(a).

11. Concurrent study in more than one program

- (1) In regulation 22 of the principal Regulations:
- (a) Insert the words “*course or*” before the word “*program*” in the title of the section;
 - (b) Insert the words “*courses or*” before the word “*programs*” in subsection (1) and (2);
 - (c) Insert the words “*course or*” before the word “*program*”;

12. Transfer between programs

- (1) In regulation 23 of the principal Regulations:
- (a) Insert the words “*course or*” before the word “*program*” in the title of the section in the first paragraph;
 - (b) Insert the words “*courses or*” before the word “*programs*”;
 - (c) Insert the words “*course or*” before the word “*program*” in subsection(a) and (b);

13. Granting academic credit

- (1) In regulation 24 of the principal Regulations:
- (a) Insert the words “*course or*” before the word “*program*” in subsection (3)(a);
 - (b) Delete the words “*course*” and substitute the words “*unit*” in subsection(3)(b) and (c);

14. Minimum studies at Federation for an award

- (1) In regulation 25 of the principal Regulations insert the words “*course or*” before the word “*program*” in subsection (1), (2)(a), (b) and (c).

15. Approval of cross institution studies

- (1) In regulation 26 of the principal Regulations:
- (a) Insert the words “*course or*” before the word “*program*” in subsection (1);
 - (b) Delete the words “*course*” and substitute the words “*unit*” in subsection (3) and (5)(a);

16. University may allow non-award course enrolment

- (a) Delete the word “*course*” and substitute the word “*unit*” in the title of the section;

17. Students studying in programs

- (1) In regulation 29 of the principal Regulations:
- (a) Insert the words “*courses or*” before the word “*program*” in the title of the section;
 - (b) Insert the words “*courses or*” before the word “*program*” in the first paragraph;
 - (c) Delete the words “*course*” and substitute the words “*unit*” in the first paragraph;

18. No entitlement to further course enrolment

- (1) In regulation 30 of the principal Regulations:
- (a) Delete the word “*course*” and substitute the word “*unit*” into the title of the section;

(b) Delete the word “*course*” and substitute the word “*unit*” into the first paragraph;

(c) Insert the word “*unit*,” before the words “*course or a program*” in the first paragraph;

19. Administration of assessment

(1) In regulation 31 of the principal Regulations insert the words “*courses or*” before the word “*program*” in subsection (2).

20. Alternate learning task and assessment

(1) In regulation 32 of the principal Regulations delete the words “*course*” and substitute the word “*unit*” in subsection (1) and (2).

21. Review of final grade

(1) In regulation 34 of the principal Regulations delete the words “*course*” and substitute the word “*unit*” in subsection (1), (1)(a), (1)(a)(i), (1)(b), (1)(c) and (3)(a).

22. Time limits for Program Completion

(1) The principal Regulations are amended as follows:

(a) insert the words “*Course or*” before the word “*Program*” in the title of Division 6;

(b) insert the words “*course or*” before the word “*program*” in the title of regulation 35;

(c) insert the words “*course or*” before the word “*program*” in regulation 35 (1);

23. Student responsibility

(1) In regulation 36 of the principal Regulations insert the words “*course or*” before the word “*program*” in subsection (1).

24. Unsatisfactory progress

(1) The regulation 38 of the principal Regulations:

(a) Delete the expression “*program or course*” and substitute the expression “*course, program or unit*” in subsection (2) (a);

(b) insert the words “*course or*” before the word “*program*” in subsection (2) (c) and (d);

25. Sanctions for student misconduct

(1) In regulation 52 of the principal Regulations delete the phrase “*course or program*” and substitute the expression “*unit, course or program*” in subsection (1) (j).
