Conflict of interest	<p>Definition of conflict of interest unclear</p>	<p>Conflict of interest in relation to academic promotion clarified</p>

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Supporting evidence	Unlimited evidence provided in a OneDrive folder	<p>No supporting evidence required for Level B</p> <p>Maximum of ten A4 pages for Levels C, D and E Supporting evidence may only include evidence referenced in the application form</p> <p>Combined and Focused - Research and creativity applications must include the applicant's current three-year research plan</p> <p>Combined and Focused - Learning and teaching applications must include current SELT / SFS scores.</p>
Word limits and formatting	<p>Total word limit per application up to 5,950 words</p> <p>Graphs, tables and images permitted in application forms</p>	<p>Total word limit per application reduced to 1,000 (Level B); 1,900 (Level C); 2,150 (Levels D and E).</p> <p>Tables, charts and other graphics are not to be included in the application form. They may however be referenced in the application and included in full in the supporting evidence document</p>
Submission process	Application and supporting evidence submitted via OneDrive	Application and supporting evidence submitted as a single PDF document and emailed to od@federation.edu.au
Appeals and feedback	Intention to appeal followed by formal appeal to be submitted within 10 days	Simplified appeals process with a 10-day deadline to lodge an appeal
