



Government public health directions




The Victorian Government issues **enforceable directions** under the emergency provisions of the Public Health Act.

They cover many aspects of the management of the pandemic, such as detention orders, border crossings, wearing masks, visits to care facilities and hospitals, etc. Some are specifically targeted at **workplaces** and include provisions applicable to educational institutions.

Federation University's Transition Control Group closely monitor the frequently updated directions and adapt our organisational response accordingly.



FedUni's COVIDSafe Plan




The university's **COVIDSafe Plan** turns the government directions into a set of operational principles, processes and practices to ensure:

- The health and safety of all members of the university community
- Compliance with government directions and other relevant legislation




COVIDSafe transition to campus process



- COVIDSafe HIRAC
- Planning and consultation (staff, HSRs, Facilities Services, ...)
- Approval
- Online induction
- Blended workforce principles
- Review
- Auditing




University contributions to COVID health and safety



- Planned and gradual transition to campus
- Information, training and education
- Enhanced cleaning and disinfection
- Provision of hand sanitiser stations and disinfectant wipes
- Signage
- Compliance with occupancy limits ("density quotients" and distancing)
- Record keeping (timetabling, QR codes, etc.)
- Centralised reporting process and liaison with authorities for prompt contact tracing



Individual contributions from staff and students



Cooperation is essential between all parts of the university (corporate level, Schools and Directorates, and all members of the university community)

- Stay home if unwell, contact HR Hotline and get tested
- Maintain physical distancing
- Minimise face-to-face interactions in enclosed spaces
- Wear masks as directed
- Practise good hand and respiratory hygiene
- Clean workstation and equipment
- Remind your staff and students if compliance issues arise
