## Glossary

**Exclusion (EX)** – a unit that is the equivalent to another and so excludes students from repeating an equivalent unit

## Course Rules

**Unsatisfactory:** Fail any unit in a Term

**Exclusion:** 2 Consecutive Unsatisfactory terms OR fail a Unit 2 times
